



iPad agreement

Vasa övningsskola lends its students an iPad. The tablet with accessories is referred to below as the equipment. The loan is valid for at least one school year. The purpose of the loan is for the equipment to add value to teaching and to replace traditional teaching materials with digital equivalents.

To access the equipment, the student and the guardian must commit to the following conditions:

1. This agreement applies from the time the students receive the equipment until it is returned to the school. The agreement is binding for the entire loan period.
2. The school acquires the equipment and the intended software and is responsible for installation and upgrading.
3. The equipment is stored at the school during the summer holidays.
4. The school has the right to immediate access to the equipment for upgrading software, service, control, and maintenance when needed.
5. The equipment is used according to the teacher's instructions.
6. The equipment is stored, when not in use, at the location specified by the teacher.
7. The equipment should be charged after school hours. If the equipment is taken home, it should be charged there so that it is ready for use the following school day.
8. The student is responsible for ensuring that the equipment is not used in a way that violates applicable legislation, such as by downloading copyrighted material.
9. Material that may be perceived as offensive or abusive must not be stored on the equipment. The student must also not use the equipment to harass or bully another person.
10. The student may not install software on the equipment that has not been approved by the school. (Technical responsible, program responsible, or principal.)
11. The guardian and teacher instruct the student on how to use the equipment while considering laws and good manners.
12. The equipment may not be borrowed or transferred to others.
13. The equipment should be used and transported with the specified protective cover.
14. The equipment should not be left unattended in visible locations in vehicles or public places.
15. The student is responsible for compensating for damage to the equipment caused by intention or negligence.
16. In case of theft or loss of the equipment or if a fault occurs, the student must report this to the school within a week.
17. The school may terminate the agreement in the following cases:
 - a. if the student violates provisions under this agreement
 - b. if the student leaves the school
18. If the agreement ends, the student is responsible for returning the equipment to the agreed person (class teacher or IT staff). The equipment should be in the same condition as when delivered, except for normal wear and tear or damage covered by warranty.
