Research: The Fellow will be given access to research facilities necessary to carry out the research training / visit. The research funding will be decided by Johan Gadolin Process Chemistry Centre at Åbo Akademi University depending on the type and the length of the research project

Stipend: Doctoral scholars will receive a stipend of 1500 EUR/month. Postdoctoral researchers will receive a stipend of 2000 EUR/month.

Our requirements for the Johan Gadolin Scholarship Programme's doctoral students and postdoctoral researchers are the following:

Mobility:

Doctoral student fellows may not carry out their fellowship in the country of their nationality. Fellows must have a valid passport and must be allowed to travel to or from Finland.

Postdoctoral fellows may not carry out their fellowship in the country of their nationality and his/her recent centre of activity. Hosts cannot appoint researchers who have carried out their normal activity in the country where the research is going to take place for more than 12 months in the two years immediately prior to their selection by the host. Fellows may not carry out their fellowship at Johan Gadolin Process Chemistry Centre, if they normally pursue their postdoctoral research anywhere in Finland.

Research Experience: The scheme is directed to postgraduate researchers pursuing doctoral studies or post-doc research in a subject area similar to that of the *PCC*. In case of doctoral studies, the stay must be directly relevant to the studies pursued. The stay at the *PCC* must be recognized as an integral part of the doctoral studies in writing by the research supervisor of the doctoral studies in the home university.
