





Nordic citizens: skip to number 2.

**EU / EEA citizens: Register your right for residence** at the nearest Migri (immigration office) service point for longer stays than 3 months.

Other citizens: If you do not yet have a residence permit or need to renew your fixed-term residence permit, apply for it in good time (earliest 3 months before) online. When you apply for residence permit, you should also make sure to obtain a personal identity (social security) number.

Register (all family members in person) at the Digital and Population Data Services Agency your place of residence / your permanent home address in Finland for stays more than a year (DVV will check if you meet the requirements). A home municipality gives access to local public services e.g. daycare, school, healthcare.

Strong identification with Suomi.fi authorization is needed in Finland in all e-services (registrations, tax and employment matters + shopping etc.). For this you need internet banking credentials. First apply for an **official ID card at the Police**. for booking an appointment to the Police office.

Open a bank account and ask for internet banking credentials, as this is needed for all online services with e.g. different authorities.

You need **strong identification** at the bank, and this is where an official Finnish ID card will come handy. Usually only a basic account is possible with your own national passport identification.

#### Spouses:

Register at the Employment and Economic Development Office (TE-Office) if you are an unemployed jobseeker (\* Only if your stay in Finland is continuous or permanent, and not e.g. for studies)

#### Spouses & children:

Apply for entitlement to health and social security at the Social Insurance Institution KELA | FPA

\* Only if your stay in Finland is continuous or permanent, and not e.g. for studies. If you are part-time working, you might be eligible to health & social insurance.

#### Weather in Vaasa


#### Dress according to weather.

- Includes at least 1 h right to change bus



- If you do not yet have your ID number, a fictitious number will be generated.



#### **Social and Health Services**

#### Visiting the H-House & registration

You can register for your visit either with a mobile device or with a registration machine (with a Kela card, driver's licence or invitation letter).

By presenting the European Health Insurance Card, you can prove your right to necessary medical treatment, i.e. medical treatment when you become suddenly ill or have an accident (when you cannot wait until you return home. You can also get treatment related to pregnancy or a chronic illness.

## Student health care and private health care

- All degree students in higher education are entitled to use the Finnish Student Health Service (FSHS).
- Pay the healthcare fee to KELA.
- Students who have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or a Global Health Insurance Card (UK GHIC) do not need to pay the KELA healthcare fee. You also do not need to take other medical insurance.
- The right to use FSHS does not exempt you from having to take out health insurance.
- Doctoral students and incoming exchange students are not entitled to use FSHS services.

- Private health care services are increasingly popular in Finland.
- With a medical insurance you can visit a private health clinic.
- In Vaasa some options are:
  - Mehiläinen
  - Pihlajalinna
  - Terveystalo
- Laboratory examinations:
  - Fimlab
  - Synlab

Get a library card for free and get access to:

- Books
- Games
- **Sports equipment**, eg. snowshoes, touring skates, kettlebells, volleyball, basketball, pétanque, disc golf, badminton sets and mölkky (the most popular summer game with friends)
- **Bicycles** for up to one week at a time (3 available)
- **Tools:** litter pickers, tool kits, electricity usage monitor, sound level meter, impact drill etc.
- **E-sources** such as e-books, e-audiobooks, PressReader, Viddla (movie streaming)
