- About 36.000 printed journal titles, and more than 100.000 licensed, academic journals and open acess journals. Can be accessed in the search portal Alma.
- PressReader gives you access to more than 7.000 newspapers and magazines worldwide








Library card



- Download the Tuudo app on your phone
- Choose university and log in with the ÅA username
- The Tuudo app has a Library tab. Follow the instructions for registration!
- You will get your library card number and a barcode. You must use the barcode when you log in to the self-checkout machine in the libraries.
- Log in to Alma with HAKA and create a PIN code. PIN is needed for self-check borrowing.

- Request, reserve and renew!



How do I request and reserve books and journals in Alma?



- In the Academill Library, Arken and ASA Libraries you'll find most of the books on open shelves.
- The Book Tower has closed stacks, and the books and journals must be requested in Alma.
- Charged books can be reserved in Alma. You'll receive an e-mail notice when the book is ready to be picked up.

How do I borrow books?



- From open shelves: fetch the book yourself
- Requested books from stacks and reserved books must be picked up within a week, course books within 3 days after email notice. You'll find these books on a self-service shelf under a code, which is in the e-mail notice.

 Borrow the books at a self-checkout machine (or at the library desk)

Loan periods



- 14 days coursebooks from the ASA Library
- 28 days for books from other collections
- Loans are renewed automatically and can be on loan for a maximum of 6/12 months if there are no reservations
- Printed journals, rare books can only be read in the reading rooms, you can scan or copy them
- Reminders will be sent to you
- Daily fees for expired loans: Course books 1€/loan/day (max. 10€/loan); other items 0,30€/loan/day (max. 6 €/loan)

 Renew your loans or return your books on time. That way, everyone has a chance of reading the books.


