The Baltic University Programme has celebrated 30 years, 1991–2021, this year. Almost all activities during the year have taken place online, but a clear focus has been to pay attention to the history, besides developing new activities.

The webinar series "Space Bridge 2.0" where all the national centers within BUP have hosted one session each throughout the year is a part of the celebration year. Another is the collection of BUP stories to a publication that will be finished during 2022.

On the same time, an active work is ongoing with developing new course materials on the key themes of BUP with the purpose to be open for all member universities. To better connect to the students in the member universities, a call for BUP student ambassadors was open during the spring 2021.

Today 95 universities and higher education institutions are members within BUP and the network is appointed a flagship project in the policy area of education as part of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR).
