Turku University of Applied Sciences cancelled its membership in spring 2022 but seems to make a comeback in 2023. University of Oulu is also interested to join.

#### Introduction

The year 2022 has been turbulent for the whole BUP cooperation, due to Russia's offensive war in Ukraine. The situation has a direct and concrete impact on BUP with 17 member universities in Ukraine. The BUP coordinating secretariate reacted immediately and according to the directives from Uppsala University. The result was that the cooperation within BUP can continue, but the member countries diminished from twelve to ten (no member universities from Russia and Belarus). The total number of member universities was 97 in February, and in the end of the year 88 (some newcomers included). Different kind of support actions for Ukraine and especially Ukrainian researchers, has been taken, for example the initiative Baltic Science Bridge lead by the associated BUP secretariat in Hamburg.

Two years after the original plans, the BUP Rectors' Conference, and the same time the celebration of BUP 30 years, took place at Uppsala University in late September.

BUP Finland is happy to again be able to arrange courses face to face after the Covid break. Together with Riga Technical University and SWEDESD (Research and learning for sustainable development and global health) at Uppsala University, Åbo Akademi University arranged the first BUP Science Lab, a workshop for promoting teachers in higher education to write manuscripts for publication on their teaching and learning experience. After a break of two years, the BUP Teachers' Course was able to start a new round.

Development of a new course platform (cc-licensed) suitable for courses on undergraduate level or self-studies are under development within BUP (<a href="https://slu-se.eu-west.catalog.canvaslms.com/browse/balticuniv">https://slu-se.eu-west.catalog.canvaslms.com/browse/balticuniv</a>). ÅAU is responsible for two courses/material packages. The material for *The Baltic Sea Environment – Challenges and Solutions* has been developed during 2022 by MSc Karin Madsén.



BUP Finland also holds the presidency within BUP for the autumn 2022. Due to the Rectors' conference and the other regular activities, the only occasion due to the presidency was the online seminar on sustainable foot- and handprints at Finnish universities (*i.e.* BUP members).

BUP is appointed a flagship project in the policy area of education as part of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR).
