Domestic and international internship funding






- Normally, an internship or other relevant work period can be included in your studies (you can get credits for it)
 - You will need to find a suitable internship position yourself
- Domestic internships (voucher)
 - Possibility to apply for an internship voucher (= a part of your salary is funded by the university) for an internship position
 - Available for all students once
- International internships
 - ERASMUS+ internships grants for positions in Europe for 3-6 months
 - Can be a paid or unpaid position

Be persistent!

Not always easy to get part-time, internship and summer jobs for students

Very common to do even basic jobs (cashier, cleaning, waitering etc.) during your studies

Be active!

- "Jobs don't come to you You have to go to them"
- Build on your networks
- Also use other services as the Employment Office, Professors and other university personel,
 Recruiting Agencys and personal contacts
- Try to get an internship position in Finland during your studies
- Be entrepreneurial and/or take part in projects and the startup scene
 - Boost Turku Community, "Yrittäjät" (national & local organisation for small enterprises)

Be active to learn languages!
