# The Finland-Swedish national library

- Over **2 million print books and journals** and **access to hundreds of thousands of e-books and e-articles!**
- ÅAUL is a **legal deposit library** and receives a copy of every book and journal printed in Finland.
- Two service units in Åbo (Astra and Arken), one in Vasa (Academill).
- **It's free for ÅAU students and staff to order books between Åbo and Vasa.**

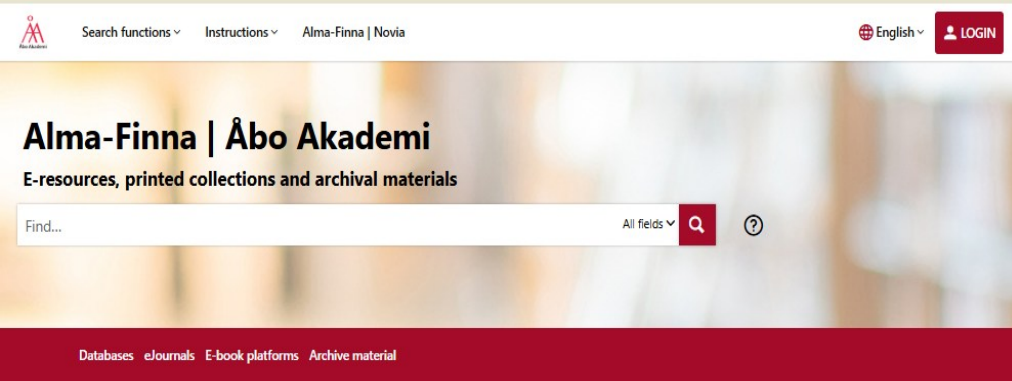

# Academill library

- Self service library with literature for the subjects at ÅAU in Vasa
- With a **HID key** you have access to the collections whenever the key is activated to Academill.
- **Check out and return books yourself**
- Staff is present at the service desk
  - **Mon-Wed, Fri 12.00-14.00**
  - **Thursdays 14.00-17.00**

- Reserve** checked out books, **request** from stacks or from Åbo, **renew** loans, **pay** fines...

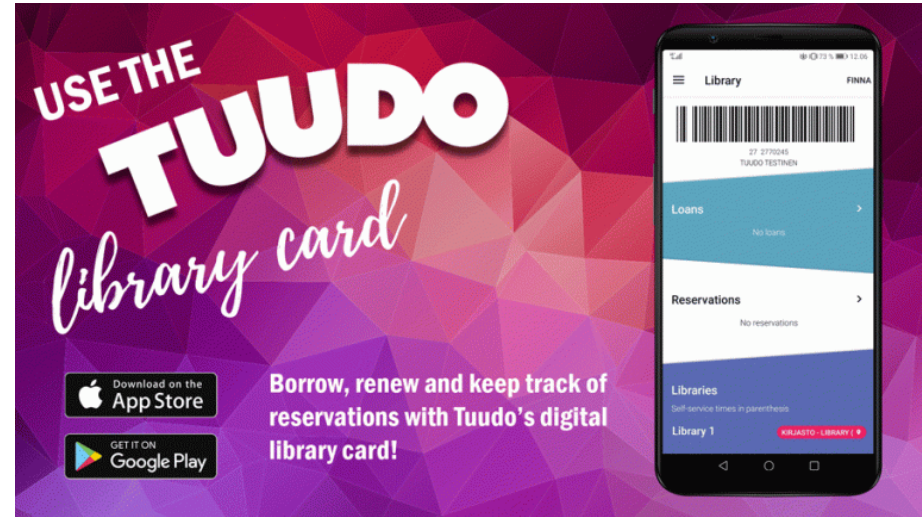

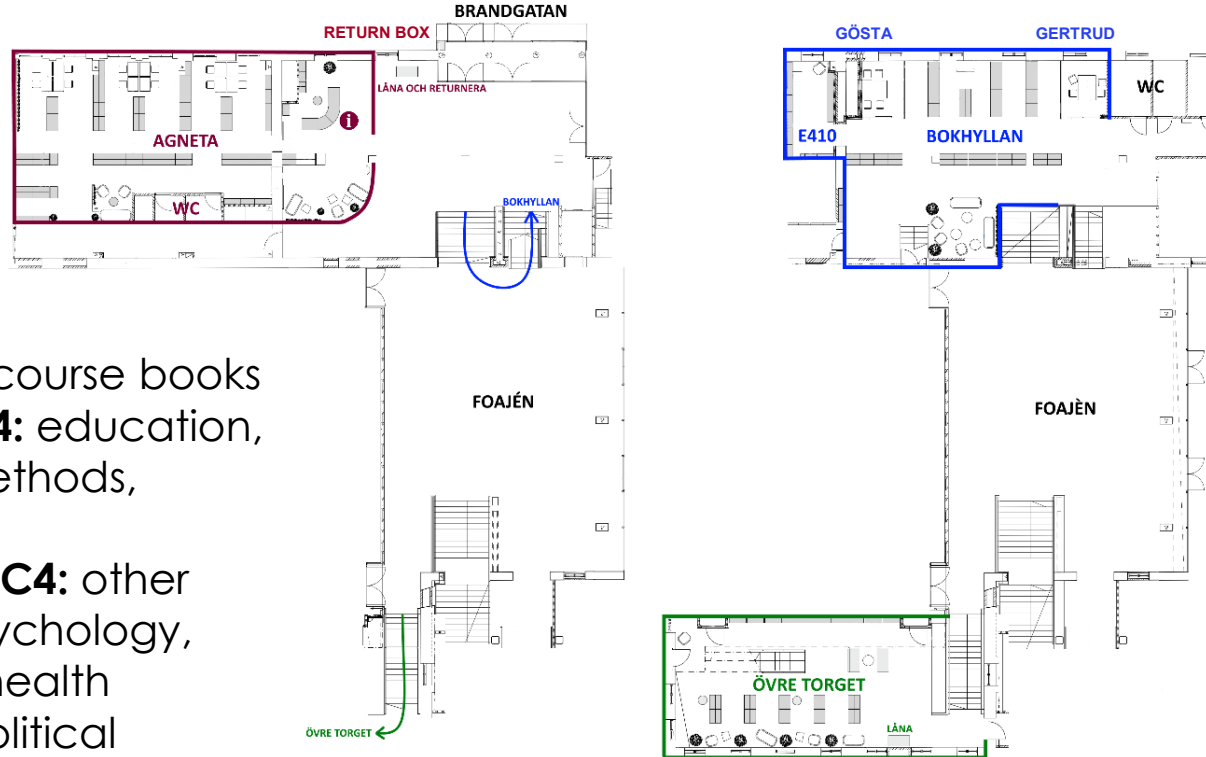


# Get a library card in Tuudo!

1. Download the **Tuudo app** to your phone.
2. Log in with your ÅAU user name (HAKA)
3. Follow the instructions at **Library** (further instructions: [https://abo.finna.fi/Content/login\\_libcard#section4](https://abo.finna.fi/Content/login_libcard#section4) )
4. **Use the app as library card.** The barcode and PIN is needed when checking out with the self service machine.



# Map of the Academill Library



- **Agneta E3:** course books
- **Bokhyllan E4:** education, research methods, languages
- **Övre torget C4:** other subjects; psychology, social and health sciences, political sciences etc.



# How to borrow print material

- The books are in open shelves.  
**Check out and return with the self service machine!**
- **Loan periods:**
  - **14 days** course books/**1 day** short loans
  - **28 days** other collections
- The loans (except the short loans) are **automatically renewed** for **6/12 months**.



# Reserve books on loan

- If the book you want is on loan:
  1. Make a **reservation** in Alma.
  2. You will get an e-mail with a **pick up code** (e.g. HJ-E-32413) when the book is available
  3. Pick up the book from the **reservation shelf in Agneta** where the books are shelved according to the code
  4. Remember to **check out the book** at the self service machine!



# Overdue fees

- You get an **e-mail** when
  - Someone has reserved your loan = the book must be returned!
  - The book has been on loan for 6/12 months = come to the library and return or check out the book again
- Short loans must be returned the following day **at 12 o'clock**
- **Overdue fees**
  - **Course books: 1 €/day (at most 10 €/loan)**
  - **Short loans: 10 €/loan**
  - **Other loans: 0,30 €/day (at most 6 €/loan)**
- Your borrowing rights are suspended when fees amount to 10 €!  
Return overdue loans and pay the fees in Alma or at the service desk.
