How?

Offers basic, intermediate and some advanced level courses from many different fields

Open to everyone, regardless of age and educational background

Follows the curricula of Åbo Akademi University, and the content, quality and level of the courses are equivalent to undergraduate studies


The structure of the courses

- The courses have been planned to accommodate adult learners.
- Most courses are completely offered online (online lectures, assignments on learning platforms or equivalent).
- Teaching is organized mainly in the evenings and at weekends.
- Flexibility in time and place where needed.



Course fees

- Degree students at Åbo Akademi University do not need to pay the course fee, including exchange students.
- Open University courses have a course fee for adult learners (60-120 euros).






Some statistics

- Annually more than 3500 students and in total 225 courses within 54 subjects
- All courses in English are offered online

- We offer 33 courses in 11 different subjects in English in 2025-2026
- For enrolment for Open University courses use Peppi (ÅAU's study planning tool)
- Enrolment for spring term is open
