

# Higher Education Pedagogy courses

Åbo Akademi University offers online courses in higher education pedagogy for the 2026-2027 academic year. These courses blend theoretical and practical knowledge tailored to participants' interests and needs. The workshops offer venues for practical exercises, discussions and collaboration.

A master's degree is required, but courses can be taken in any order. All courses are graded on a pass/fail basis.

1 credit equates to approximately 27 hours of coursework. Detailed information about the courses is sent via email two weeks prior to the start.
