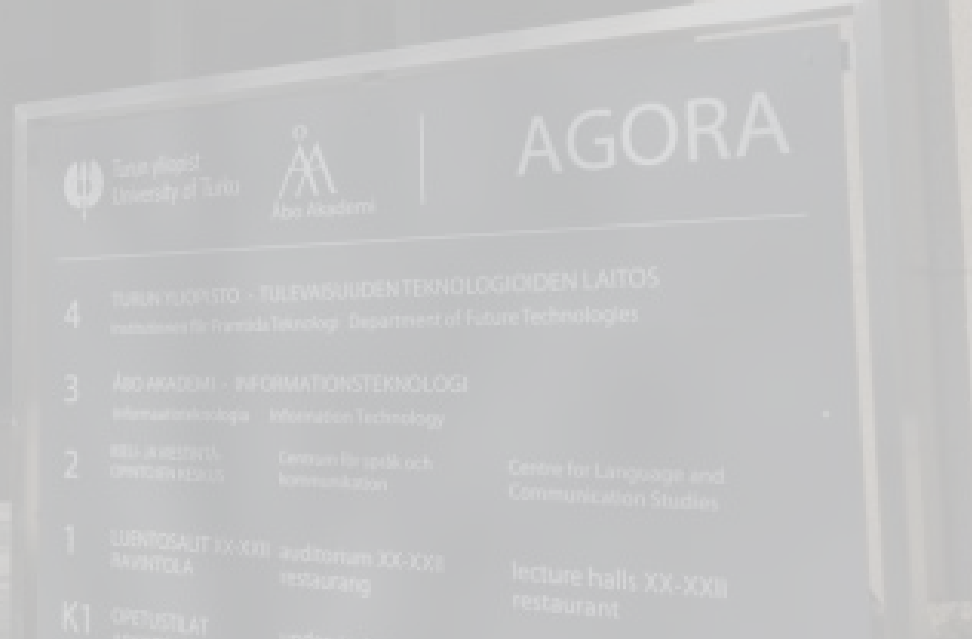


TUTOR GREETING: MSC INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
